Poster Presentation Guidelines

Thank you for contributing to the promotion of doctoral research through your participation in the poster session. Please follow the guidelines below for an optimal presentation:

Poster Format

- Maximum size: A0 (84.1 cm x 118.9 cm)
- **Orientation**: Portrait only
- Language: English
- **Material**: Printed on rigid or flexible paper (no digital posters)
- Must be readable from 1.5 metres away

Recommended Content

Your poster should be clear, structured, and understandable to a non-specialist audience. We recommend including the following:

- 1. Project title (short and informative)
- 2. Author(s) name(s), laboratory, institution
- 3. Introduction and background
- 4. Study objectives
- 5. Methodology
- 6. Results (with graphs, tables, images, etc.)
- 7. Conclusion and outlook
- 8. References (if needed)
- 9. Contact details or a QR code (optional)

• If you do not yet have results, you may present only the background and methods.

• During the Forum

- You must be present at your poster for the full duration of the poster session to interact with participants and jury members
- You may be assigned a **specific presentation time** depending on the organisation

Installation / Removal

- Posters must be installed **on the morning of 5 June** (exact time to be confirmed) on designated panels
- Please remove your poster at the end of the event **on 6 June**. Unclaimed posters may be discarded.
